

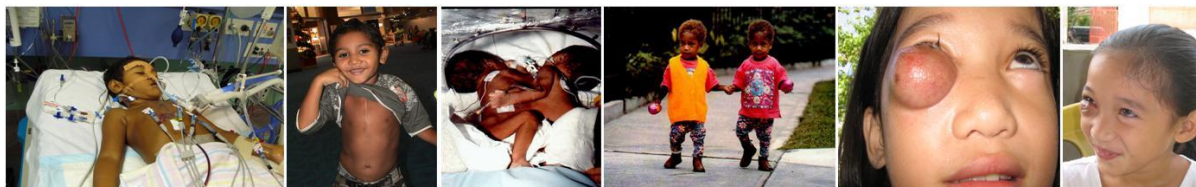


Mission Statement
