Report from meeting held on Monday 14 August 2017 at the Grenville Community Connections Hub

President Alan in his opening of the meeting welcomed members – Anthony James, Jim Buckoke, Delwyn Watts, Lesley Trevilyan, Shirley Halls, Jackie Webb, Gay Smallwood-Smith, Viv Valladares, David Adamson, Elizabeth Adamson, Margaret Green, and Sharka Byrne, and guests Robin Trevilyan from the Rotary Club of Playford, and Tony Moore and Paul Schmelzkopf from Hoops 4 Life.

Sergeant Lesley gave the toast to the Queen, the people of Australia, and the invocation.

Chairperson PP Jim called for spots.

P Alan indicated that our next Bunnings barbecue is on Tuesday 29th August. He has sent around the roster and the response has been prompt; we could still use one or two people especially for the last shift. We also have the final Holden's barbecue coming up on Saturday 16th September from 3pm to 8:30pm. The roster is out so please let P Alan know as soon as possible if you are able to assist. We really need more support for this event as we have only five people so far.

Could all members who need to submit a report for the annual report please do so as Raelene cannot put the report together until she has the information. It would be greatly appreciated if this could be done so the annual report can be presented to the DG Peter Schaefer during his visit on the 21st August.

There have been some changes to the District Governor's visit on the 21st August due to him not arriving until approximately 5pm. All of the tours have been cancelled, however the board will still meet in the Mayor's Parlour at 5pm.

P Alan has asked members of the board to prepare a brief on their role and give the DG an outline of your goals for the coming year. He has asked for detailed financial and president's reports.

- 4 Elizabeth informed members that the BreastScreen mobile unit will be at Lyell McEwin Hospital from the 19th to the 29th of September and at the John McVeity Centre from the 12th to the 15th of September. As a reward for attending, "have a little screen and get a free ticket to the big screen."
- Jackie spoke to members about Mental Health First Aid training, possible on Oct 10th and 17th. The usual cost is \$300 per person; we can get a discount of \$150 per person as Rotary. If we can get eight people we may get it free. The course teaches adults how to assist people who are having a mental health crisis or developing a mental health problem.
- Gay informed members on Shirley's behalf that the Playford Community Carols will be on 3rd December from 6:30pm and will include Rachael Leahcar and Anthony Callea as headline acts.

Delwyn spoke about the Northern Light Theatre Company's production of Annie. She is looking at going on Friday 20th October at 8pm. Tickets are: Adults - \$30, Concession - \$25, Children under 16 - \$20, and family tickets (2 adults and 2 children 4 tickets) are \$22.50 each; ie \$90 for four.

After dinner Chairperson PP Jim introduced our guest speaker Tony Moore from Hoops 4 Life. Tony is originally from Harlem in New York. He came from a poor neighbourhood where racism was common as were gangs. Tony joined a gang for protection; better to be a target of two gangs rather than three. He turned his life around and moved to Australia in 1988.

Hoops 4 Life was started in the United States of America by a

basketball player who didn't make it into the NBA. Basketball is used as a vehicle to help troubled youth improve themselves and

break up gangs. Many aspects of basketball such as music, fashion, the game, and the players draws young people. In the US the program is supported by the NBA and WNBA.

The program helps disadvantaged, marginalised youth and youth with disabilities. All are welcome. They have youth from many cultures and backgrounds many of whom would not get a chance to participate in team sports. As the young people feel that they belong they start to open up.

Through the use of basketball based training program the young people learn about teamwork, leadership, communication skills, and emotional control. After being through the program many young people help teach the program to others.

Young people can now obtain SACE units from being through the Hoops 4 Life Program.

Sergeant Lesley awarded fines. The raffle was drawn by Tony Moore being won by Gay.

President Alan then closed Meeting 2537 and thanked everyone for attending.
