In a twist the club travelled to Mallala for this week's meeting, to the home town of two of our members Jackie and Raelene who regularly travel the distance to meet at the Grenville Centre, ironically for a change they would be tucked up in bed before the rest of us travelled the distance back to civilisation. Members of the club had dinner at the Mallala Hotel before having a tour of the Mallala Museum. Afterwards members had a drink at Rotarian Jackie's home before heading home.

Elizabeth informed members that ShelterBox 14797, donated by our club, has been delivered to a family on the Syrian/Turkish border. On Friday 28 April, 11 families through the Northern Domestic Violence Unit visited the Adelaide Zoo. All who attended had a fun day, eating, taking pictures and having fun. Our club contributed \$1.000.00 in February 2016 for the cost.

The Mallala and Districts Historical Committee was formed in 1968. Its collections grew rapidly and in 1970 the District Council of Mallala purchased the heritage listed Old Flour Mill for committee to use as a museum. The flour mill was erected in 1878.

The southern gallery of the museum houses displays highlighting local government, business and social activities, and the hardships faced by those who first settled the district. Photographs, documents, and other memorabilia detail the families, sport, social and service organisations that formed the backbone of life.

The middle gallery contains the military and service history of the district. The displays have information on local involvement from the Boer War through the World Wars, and more recent peace keeping operations. Of particular note are the significant displays on RAAF No 6 Service Flight Training School which opened in 1941 with the first class starting 22 September 1941.

The northern gallery and pastoral shed contain the agricultural displays of farm machinery, and includes a Blacksmith Forge, a penny farthing, and REO Speedwagon Fire Engine.

In the courtyard of the museum the Long Plains schoolroom has been relocated. It now houses the artifacts and archives that tell the educational history of the district.
