After dinner Chairperson Gay introduced our guest speaker, Past District Governor Doug Layng who spoke about a few recollections from the conference in Atlanta and about Mini -Projects.

There were multiple opening ceremonies so that all of the attendees could go. Each attendee was assigned to a particular session and their ID tag would let the staff know if you were in the wrong session. During this early session the End Polio program was discussed. One and a half billion US dollars is needed over the next three years to put an end to polio. Within thirty minutes of this being said \$1.2 billion had been donated. This is to do vaccinations in areas that still need to be done and maintain the herd immunity in others. Once we've had a Polio free year a three year countdown will begin. If after three years no new Polio cases

are reported then Polio will have been eradicated.

The Mini – Projects session was about projects that are small enough they can be done during regular meetings for example. These projects have included making party bags with party supplies or organising dictionaries for school children.

New members can be quickly engaged in projects by getting them to work together on a mini-project; giving them a certain amount of funds to pool with other new members in such a venture. Keeping new and long term members engaged will help retain members and is also good for accumulation of service hours.

A new membership type that has been introduced by some clubs is that of a service member. These members attend at least one meeting per month and engage in 16.25 hours of service per month (as an example). This then makes them a sustaining member. One concept Doug talked about was pre-payment of meals, that is the meal cost is included in the annual dues, therefore the club has no problem if by chance they don't show up for a meeting.

Sergeant Lesley handed out fines. The raffle was drawn by PDG Doug and won by Anthony and Jackie.

President Alan then closed Meeting 2542 and thanked everyone for attending.
