#### Report from meeting held on Monday 30 October 2017 at the South Australian Aviation Museum

President Alan welcomed members – Delwyn Watts, Lesley Trevilyan, David Adamson, Elizabeth Adamson, Jackie Webb, Shirley Halls, Jim Buckoke, Raelene Trickett, as well as visitors Robin Trevilyan and Mitchell Adamson to the South Australian Aviation Museum for a social event.

The South Australian Aviation Museum was established in 1984 and commenced operations behind the former Pier Hotel at Glenelg in the old Ravens Garage with one aircraft the Avro Anson and some aviation artefacts. In October 1986 notice was given to the Museum to vacate the building by November, a frantic search and pleading resulted in them being given a lease to the SA Lion Flour Mill in Port Adelaide.

They moved in in November 1986 and commenced operations. They spent hundreds of hours cleaning the pigeon infested building and set up the displays. In 1988 they applied to the History Trust of South Australia for accreditation, they were not successful but were advised of the things to improve and in 1990 were granted provisional accreditation with full accreditation being granted in January 2000.

In 1996 a further move was made when an aircraft hangar became available at the corner of Ocean Steamers Drive and Honey Street, Port Adelaide. After the move the Museum's collection was revitalised by adding a mezzanine gallery, and allowing entry into some of the aircraft.

The start of the new Port River Bridges project resulted in another move to the current position in Lipson Street. Extensions were added as well as a workshop and administration areas. The premises were officially opened on the 20 May 2006.

Today the Museum continues to develop through the addition of new displays, restorations and general improvement of presentation and facilities. It remains a totally volunteer organisation.

We enjoyed an interesting evening being shown around by John and Mike two very knowledgeable gentlemen who seem to have endless information about each aircraft and lots of interesting stories about the people who flew and have worked on the aircraft and in the Museum. Dinner was held at the Birkenhead Tavern.
