After dinner Chairperson David introduced our guest speaker, Bill Doyle. Bill spoke about Buffers for Bushland, a city program to replace and renew local native plants to the area. Bill's love of Australian native flora was apparent in his talk.

Buffers to Bushland is a local rural scheme to grow and redistribute local-native seedlings to rural properties and schools in the Playford Council District which began in 1999. Over the years the scheme has distributed seedlings to 290 properties and schools of which 203 are on the current mailing list. They distribute around 15,000 seedlings per year with the total seedlings distributed being over 210,000.

Everything begins from the seeds and the volunteers. The seedlings are grown at the Playford Operations Centre nursery in Davoren Park. The volunteers assist in seed collection and have made a major contribution to and maintenance of the Little Para Orchard in Hillbank which supplies about 50% of the seeds. The volunteers also assist the annual Boxing-Up Day where 10-20,000 seedlings into multiple-species boxes for Buffers Distribution.

Property owners take part in the Boxing-Up Day and help to make their own mixed-species boxes. In 2015 seedlings were provided to 2 Buffers properties that were affected by the Sampson Flat Fires.

Sergeant Lesley handed out fines. The raffle was drawn by Peter Greig and Bill Doyle and won by Peter and Shirley.

President Alan then closed Meeting 2549 and thanked everyone for attending.
