Despite the challenges of such a complex crisis, I'm pleased to be able to tell you that your ShelterBox aid, in the name of "The Rotary Club of Elizabeth Inc" has been given to families in desperate need on the Syrian/Turkish border.

Ben Rowe, of Street-Light, spoke of his vision to support the youth in Elizabeth through contact at Elizabeth City Centre. Many youth are disconnected from society and the program aims to build relationships with youth in the community and to empower them. Seven-Eight volunteers meet by the Shopping Centre entrance near Reading Cinemas on a Thursday night. They discover the youth's potential after gaining their trust and have network with many programs for youth available in the community.
