Paola Mavrogiannis

After dinner P Alan introduced our guest speaker for the night, Paola Mavrogiannis, A/Key Partnerships and Fundraising Manager, St John Ambulance Australia SA Inc. Paola has worked within the Academic, State Government and Global recruitment fields as an Executive Assistant.

She was the Personal Assistant to the Chief Executive Officer at St John Ambulance from 2011 to 2015.

In 2016 Paola transferred to the Corporate and Commercial team and worked as the Personal Assistant to the General Manager where she was also the Project Coordinator of various company projects.

In 2017 she took on her current role as the Key Partnerships and Fundraising Manager on an interim basis. Paola has a passion for fundraising and enjoys knowing that her contribution will end up giving funds to much needed volunteers. She is keen to explore new possibilities in the fundraising field, giving it the energy, creativity and versatility it needs.

Paola spoke about the First Aid in Schools Program. This program provides free first aid training in schools for students from reception to Year 7 and is endorsed by the State Government. The level of first aid training and the session length are determined by the age of the children. The program has so far taught over 45,000 children at a cost of over \$200,000.

The FAiS program aims to empower the students to recognise an emergency and take appropriate action and introduce them to first aid. The children are also encouraged to start a conversation at home and in their communities about first aid.

There are over 158,000 primary school students in South Australia and the program costs \$10 per child. This results in cost that would be \$200,000 per year in its current form. As a result the program is being revamped. An online donations portal has been developed that enables schools, donors and sponsors to do their own fundraising. St John Ambulance are also applying for grants.

St John Ambulance received a grant from the Commonwealth Bank and have decided to use this grant in the Playford area.

Sergeant Lesley handed out fines.

The raffle was drawn by Paola and Birgitta and won by Lesley and Paola.

P Alan thanked everyone for attending and closed the meeting.
