Rosanne worked in Pakistan for seven years as an English teacher in Pakistan. The school she worked in was one that catered for girls who otherwise would not have been able to attend school. The children would tell her stories, not all of them were good. During her time in Pakistan Rosanne got many story ideas that would later be turned into books. In 2006 she returned to Pakistan in 2006 on a writing scholarship.

The topics in Rosanne's books have included children growing up in another country, forced marriages and the floods in Pakistan. Her latest book that has been out for about four weeks that Rosanne has written is about a girl from Cornwall who migrated to far north South Australia in 1911.
