Report from meeting held on Monday 4 June 2018 at St Patrick's Technical College

- ✚ John Neate said that St Patrick's were delighted to be hosting our meeting as they love the service the club provides to the community. This service resonates with the school in their own efforts to help others. John's family has a personal connection to Rotary as his brother went to Sao Paolo, Brazil as an exchange student with Rotary in 1980.

This year St Patricks are organising their third trip to Cambodia to do work for a school near Siem Riep. There are 10 students going this year compared to 7 and 14 for the first and second trips respectively. John and Branden Hill will be the supervising staff this time.

There were several staff from St Patrick's involved in helping this particular school before the school trips started. The man who started the school lost his grandparents to the Khmer Rouge. He likes to build long term relationships with people who help his school.

The projects that St Patrick's have been doing are sustainable. They have involved laying down water pipes and fixing the thatch roofs (the old roofs had been leaking). The students were the ones that worked out the details and bought the materials. They left money and materials for any repairs and further work required with labour costing about \$1AU a day. This year's project is still being decided.

This is a trip the students want to go on as they get to help others and it's a pilgrimage to learn about themselves.

✚ Danny Deptula spoke to members about how the school is different to other school being the only independent technical school in South Australia. There is still a culture in schools of pushing students towards university and not even giving a trade qualification a look in. Many students that don't do as well in an academic environment excel in a technical high school environment. Danny also mentioned that parents do not always see university as necessary to the children's future success.

The RYLA Celebration Evening 2018 is coming up on 11 July and will be held within the same complex as the next District 9500 Conference at the Three Gums Bistro, 145a Mt Barker Rd, Hahndorf. Tickets are \$20 and there is a limit of 90 in total so book early if you want to attend.
