Our meeting on 30 July was a trip to Two Wells where we visited the Two Wells CFS established in 1957. We were shown the workings by Brigade Captain Adam Harris. The brigade has two trucks; each with a slightly different setups. Differences include a number of breathing apparatus and a front mounted fire hose that can be controlled via a joystick in the cabin.

There are around sixty volunteers in the brigade including ten women. The brigade is also have twenty two cadets aged from 11 to 16 that are a great source of recruits in the future.


The brigade responded to 197 incidents in 2016-2017 which included cats in trees, birds in trees, domestic fires, country bush fires, road accidents and even sudden heart attacks of people in the area.
