The Interact clubs are chartered by Rotary International and have a sponsor Rotary club. The sponsor clubs provide a mentor to help run their meetings and provide support. In school based clubs at least one teacher is involved in running the club. The clubs pick at least one local and international project and fundraise as much as they wish for their projects.

Interactors do not pay fees unless the clubs themselves decide to levy them.
