During her first year in University Brooke was privileged to win the position of netball coach for a prestigious high school. She was able to use this position to promote health, well-being and self-esteem to all girls in the team. This became satisfying evident when they won their first two grand finals.

Brooke first got into a Bachelor of Exercise Science degree but found that she was not into it and had the opportunity of attending the Indigenous Allied Health Australia conferences for the past two years with UniSA. She was able to network with other professionals whilst gaining an understanding of various Allied Health Disciplines. Through attending the conferences she developed an understanding of Occupational Therapy and decided she wanted to follow that pathway.

After completing her degree and a Diploma in Nutrition Brooke plans on working with children specifically indigenous educating them on the importance of healthy lifestyle choices although she wants to experience a wide range of fields in Occupational Therapy through placement opportunities. Longer term Brooke wants to own her own practice.
