After dinner Chairperson P Elizabeth introduced our guest speaker for the evening, DG David Egan. DG David has been president of three clubs in his time as a Rotarian. He was president of the Rotary Club of Adelaide in 2015-2016. At the time the club's membership was mostly aging Anglo-Saxon men. They knew they had to change and change they did so that now their club membership is very diverse.

Declining membership is an important issue across the western world for Rotary. Some of RI president Barry Rassin's priorities are improving the membership experience, doubling the number of young leaders, finding the End Polio campaign, protecting the environment, and enhancing Rotary's public image.

A couple of the barriers that make change for Rotary more difficult are the cultural differences between generations and the annual leadership change with each new leadership team wanting to do things their way.

In District 9500 membership is down twenty-five percent in the last eight years with only twenty-four percent being female and only 1.7% being under the age of forty. The district has been responding to these need for change and helping clubs with this change.

The raffle was drawn by DG David and won by P Elizabeth and John Neate.

P Elizabeth thanked our guests for coming and reminded members that our next meeting is our joint meeting with the Playford Club on Tuesday 20 November at 6:30 p.m. for 7:00 p.m.
