**Danielle Watts** 

After dinner Chairperson Delwyn introduced our guest speaker for the evening, Danielle Watts, a former Rotary Exchange student who spent a year living in the Netherlands. Danielle wanted to go to a country where she didn't speak the language and had a list of possible countries including Germany, Switzerland, Sweden, and the Netherlands. Germany would only take students who already spoke German. She was eventually chosen to go to the Netherlands.

Danielle departed Australia in January 1991, where it was 40 degrees Celsius and went to a cold winter's day in Tiel, the Netherlands where it was minus two degrees. She also only remembered the Dutch for "orange juice" on arrival.

Tiel has a church that was built in 1430. The town is known for its orchards of apples, plums, pears and cherries.

The first host family that Danielle stayed with had a daughter on exchange in Australia and the son had broken his nose by tripping over his own feet. They also had a Great Dane which Danielle had to get used to as she had a fear of dogs.

It took Danielle four months to learn the language, whilst having a tutor and everyone around her also helping her to learn the language. Before she gained fluency in Dutch Danielle got the top mark in Biology with the lessons being taught in Dutch.

Danielle took all of the opportunities for experiences she was presented including flying in a light plane when a Rotarian needed a passenger.

The raffle was drawn by Danielle and won by Gay.
