After dinner our guest speaker for the evening, Jess Law, was introduced by Chairperson Shirley. Jess is a Community Resilience Project Officer with the Australian Red Cross. Jess came to speak about 'Community Resilience in Emergencies'.

The Australian Red Cross provides many services including first aid (physical and psychological), checking on vulnerable people such as during a heatwave and reconnecting people separated by an emergency. An emergency is defined by the Red Cross to be an event outside the community's ability to cope such as heatwave, crime and natural disasters.

Community Resilience is about being as prepared as possible before an emergency occurs. Some important measures include seventy-two hours supply of food of water and having a copy of important document ready at a moment's notice. People rely on electronic devices and need to ensure they are ready for if they don't work.

As a tsunami event in Japan in 2011 showed knowing your neighbours saves lives. Many people were helped to higher ground who would have not made it on their own. Many people get to know their neighbours with street parties which can help.

Sergeant Lyn handed out fines.
