During dinner P Elizabeth introduced our guest speaker for the evening, Beverly Reeves from the Bickford Group.

The Bickford's Group was started in 1839 by William Bickford who had migrated to South Australia on the SS Platina. He worked as a druggist at an apothecary he opened on Hindley St, Adelaide although he had originally planned on sheep farming.

William invested in a mine and repaid his loan for opening his business in just five years. He died young and his wife took over the business until their sons came of age.

The business expanded rapidly and went into other ventures such as pharmacies and veterinarian surgeries although they now only trade in beverages. The company became commercial in 1874.

The Bickford's Group today has a wide range of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages in its portfolio including the iconic brown lime cordial (which is green outside of South Australia), fruit juices, bottled water, soft drinks, rum, bourbon, cider and wine which they export to thirty-four countries throughout the world.

Wanda and Frank Gratton from the Lions spoke about the Lions Hearing Dogs. The dogs undergo socialisation training before being trained as a hearing dog.

During the socialisation phase of training the dogs are taken to new locations and situations to get them used to everyday situations. They will be taken multiple times if necessary until they are calm about it.

They undergo six months of training which costs between \$25k and \$30k per dog. The training time can be reduced when the background of the dog is known.
