P Eryn inducted Piotr Salamon into the club. Piotr was previously a member of the Rotary Club of Salisbury and his sponsor was PP David Adamson. His classification is Education.

After dinner chairperson PP Elizabeth introduced our guest speaker for the evening, Cathy Booth, founder of Umoja Orphanage in Kenya. Cathy is a Rotarian and a Paul Harris Fellow. She is a full time teacher and mother to four adult children. She uses long service leave and unpaid leave to go to Kenya.

Umoja Orphanage is RAWCS (Rotary World Community Service) project, Number 51/2011-2. The word Umoja means Togetherness.

In 2010 Cathy went to Kenya for a Safari trip and saw the poverty that many children were in. She also saw that there weren't enough children's homes to look after them. She visited many homes and eventually decided to build her own.

The project was then started on 30 July 2011. Cathy purchased land in Kenya and also had to pay for the trees. She also had meeting with the local, elders.

Over the nine years of the project they have had over one hundred and thirty volunteers aged between 21 and 86 years old. Most of these volunteers have been Rotarians. They train the locals how to do the work.

The fundraising for the first children's home took five years. The home has five bedrooms and was built by local contractors. This home was opened by the Australian High Commissioner in Kenya. They are now starting to build a second children's home.

Sustainability is a key part of the project. They operate a Safari business and sell agricultural produce they grow. They also sell eggs and milk.

PP Elizabeth thanked Cathy for speaking to us and presented her with a Rotary pen.

Delwyn and P Eryn presented Cathy with a cheque for \$1000 for Umoja Orphanage.
