They agreed to host a Japanese short term exchange student for two weeks and they ended up hosting one of the teachers who spoke fluent English. Trevor had in fact been learning Japanese in preparation but made some mistakes with it that he is still reminded off. They have been hosting Japanese students since 1997.

On their first trip to Japan Trevor didn't want to go because he doesn't like sea food and the temperature overnight was -20 degrees Celsius. In less than a day they had decided that they would be going back. Japan reminded Trevor of England. Both Trevor and Juanita have been back over twenty times.

Japan is a country where old meets new. Tradition continues with respect and friendliness very important in the culture. Respect of others is so important that Japan has one of the lowest crimes rates in the world. When Japanese hand things to another person they do it with both hands.

A clear difference occurs in a park with a lot of people having a picnic. In Japan people take their rubbish with them when they leave and there are no bins in the park where as in the west people many people will leave their rubbish behind.

Many shopping centres are underground in Japan. When you walk into a shop you will always get welcomed and each floor of a department store has one type of product in line with everything has its place.

Bushido Travel was started to share their experiences about Japan and is their way of thanking Japan.

PP David thanked Trevor for speaking to us and presented him with a Rotary pen.
