Rick id the Child Protection Officer for Rotary District 9500 and is on the Child Protection committee for the new District 9510. He is a past Group Governor and will be the Area Governor for our group in the new district.

Rick spoke to both clubs about Child Protection.

Child protection policy and systems are required by state legislation and by all levels of Rotary. Rotary International requires it for all clubs and a club's charter can be revoked for non-compliance. RI's policy covers young people up to the age of 25. One meeting per year is recommended by RI to be dedicated to child protection.

New legislation in SA now defines a prohibited person as a:

- Person issued a prohibition notice
- Person prohibited from working with children in any jurisdiction in Australia

- Person found guilty of a prescribed offence

A prohibited person is not allowed to work with children.

Under current Rotary rules anyone whose title has Youth in it, the President and the Child Protection Officer need to be screened and anyone else running a program or project with close contact with children.
